About This Guide

This Install Guide documents the installation process on an Mk8 VW Golf R. There may be minor differences depending on specific vehicle, market, options, etc.

NOTE: Adding a small amount of dielectric grease (or Vaseline) inside the spark plug boot will help prevent the boot from bonding to the spark plug, allowing for easier removal of the coil in the future.





Install Steps

Step 1

Open the hood to access the ignition coils.



Step 2

If present, remove the engine cover.

Step 3

Using a 10mm wrench and socket, remove the nut securing the ground straps to the studs.



Step 4Remove the ground straps from the studs.



Step 5Carefully disconnect the coil harness plugs from the coils.






Step 6

Carefully disconnect the coil harness plugs from the coils.



Step 7

Using a 10mm socket, remove the stud securing the coils to the valve cover.



Step 8


Carefully remove the coils by pulling up on them.



Step 9

Install the 034 ignition coils.







Step 10

Secure the coils to the valve cover with the factory studs.




Step 11

Install the coil harness connectors to the coils.



Step 12

Install the ground straps to each stud and secure them with the factory nuts with a 10mm socket.



Step 13Reinstall the PCV pressure sensor.





Step 14

Reinstall the engine cover if you wish to hide these beautiful ignition coils.



Step 15 Close your hood and you're done.
